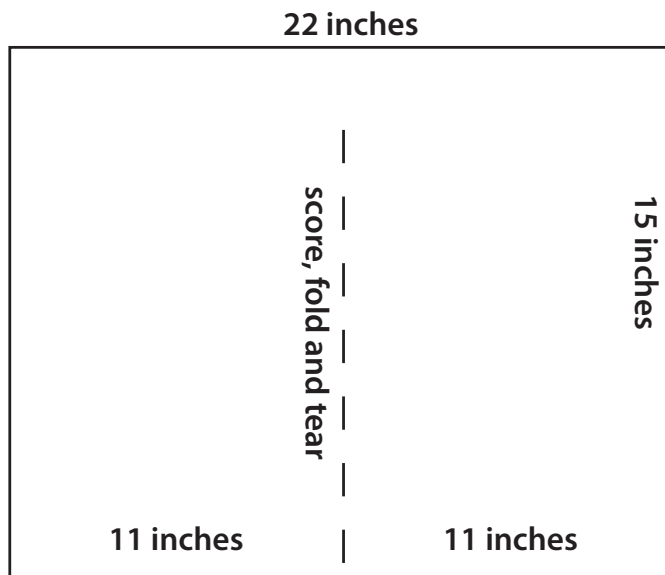
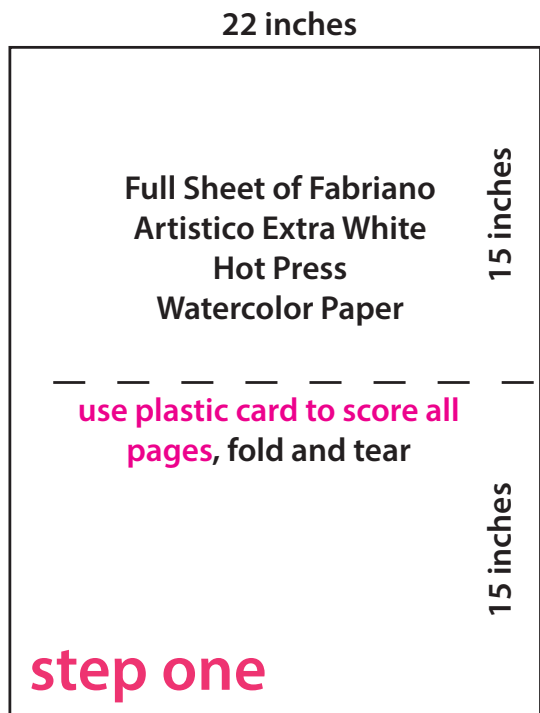


Dividing the Watercolor Sheet: Homework

So that you do not have to travel with a full sheet of paper, please divide your sheets as shown below and bring them with you loose, we will assemble in the workshop with the double sided tape. Rather than cutting the pages, fold, run a plastic card along the fold to be sure it's crisp, then carefully tear to create a deckle edge, this enhances the hand made feel. Score the 5.5-inch side of all 16 pages using a **Score-Pal** and leave them. Do not press too hard with the scoring tool, otherwise you can cut right through the sheet!



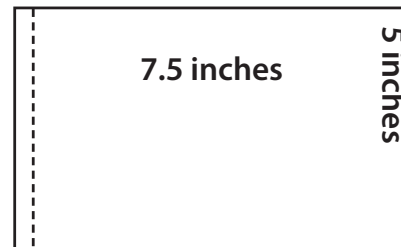

Scor-Pal and fold 7/8 inch for 1-inch double stick tape. For narrower or wider tape adjust width accordingly

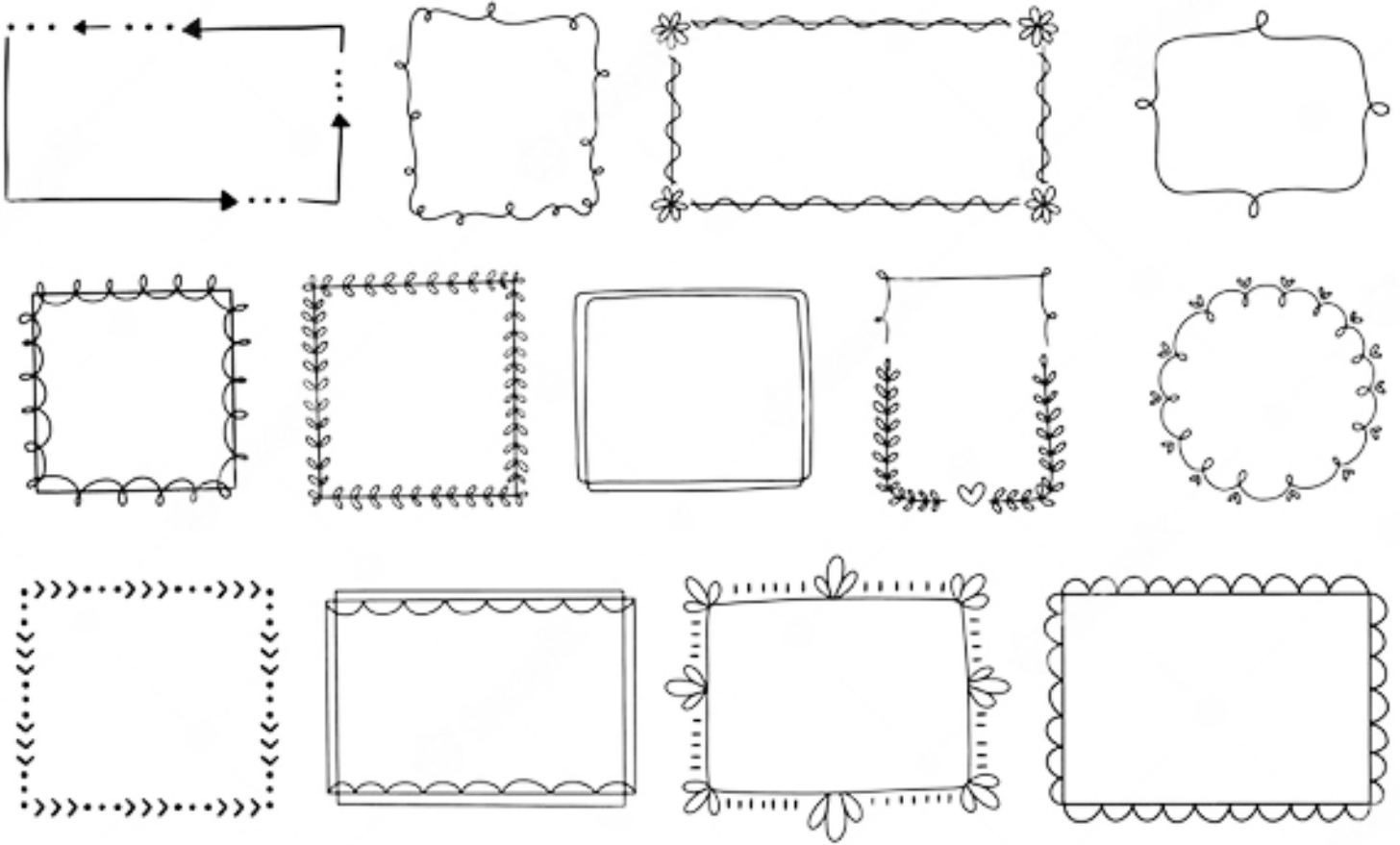
